The entire family's participation at Mass in the parish every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation is expected as set forth
both in Divine Law, the Ten Commandments, and the Precepts of the Church. This participation will be tracked
through the weekly use of the parish envelope. The parish understands that families do travel or may at times
attend other parishes on Sundays for special reasons.

All families will strive to support our parish financially, in so far as possible, understanding that our tuition payment is

not a contribution to the parish but a payment for our child(ren)'s education, which is subsidized by the parish family as a whole. As Catholic parishioners we ask the parish to help us provide our child(ren) with a Catholic Education. We understand and agree that our child(ren) will be taught the teachings of the Catholic Church in their fullness. Pastors recognize that some families are desirous of fulfilling these teachings but are not yet there. These families are highly encouraged to meet with their pastor to discuss a path forward to full participation in the life of our Church and parish. We further accept the commitment to the stewardship way of life as practiced in our parish. We pledge our full cooperation with the school and parish to prepare our child(ren) to be disciples of Jesus Christ. We will make every effort to supervise our child(ren)'s commitment to this agreement. —The parish accepts your requests for a Catholic education and your commitment to active participation with your child(ren) in the life of the parish. The parish is committed to subsidize your child(ren)'s tuition. We also acknowledge our obligation to assist you in your task of nurturing your child(ren) in the practice of the Catholic faith. We will make our best effort to form your child(ren) as disciples of Jesus Christ. My family is of another faith tradition, and we thank you for welcoming us to Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic School. We will respect and cooperate with those who provide this Catholic education—the priests, parishioners, and all school personnel, as well as their policies.
